Political and Diplomatic Ties



Prime Minister of Pakistan Mr. Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif, paid an official visit to State of Qatar on 16 April 2026



Prime Minister of Pakistan Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif undertook a day-long official visit to Doha on July 13, 2026, accompanied by former Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif, to convey his condolences to Qatar's Amir, His Highness Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al Thani, following the passing of the Father Amir, His Highness Sheikh Hamad bin Khalifa Al Thani.



HE Prime Minister Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif visited Qatar, accompanied by HE Field Marshal Syed Asim Munir NI (M), HJ, Chief of Army Staff and Chief of Defence Forces of Pakistan, for meetings with HH the Amir Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al Thani and HE Sheikh Mohammed bin Abdulrahman bin Jassim Al Thani, Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the State of Qatar.



At the Lake Lucerne Summit, HE Sheikh Mohammed bin Abdulrahman bin Jassim Al Thani, Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the State of Qatar; HE Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif, Prime Minister of Pakistan; and HE Field Marshal Syed Asim Munir NI (M), HJ, Chief of Army Staff and Chief of Defence Forces of Pakistan, held meetings with representatives of the United States and Iran for high-level discussions on regional peace, security and diplomatic cooperation.

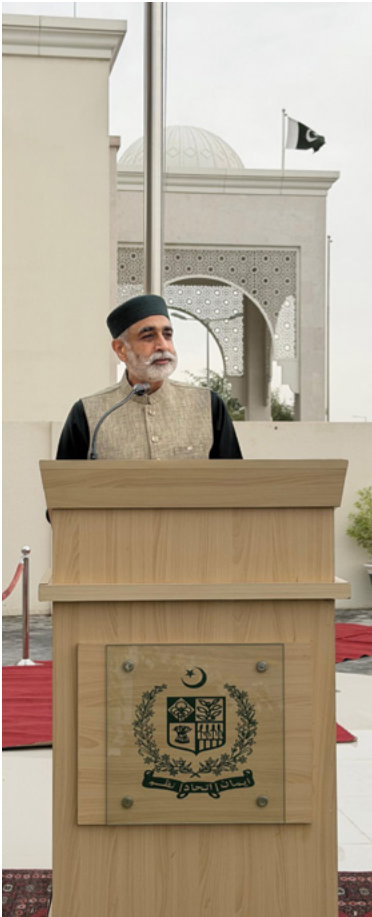

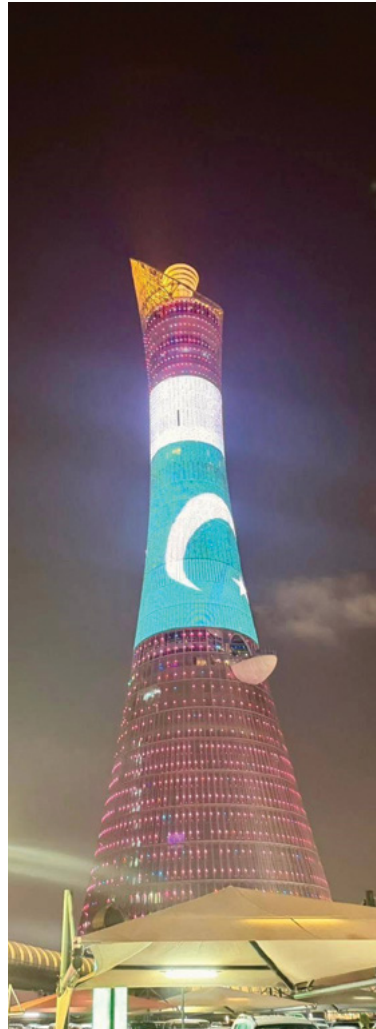

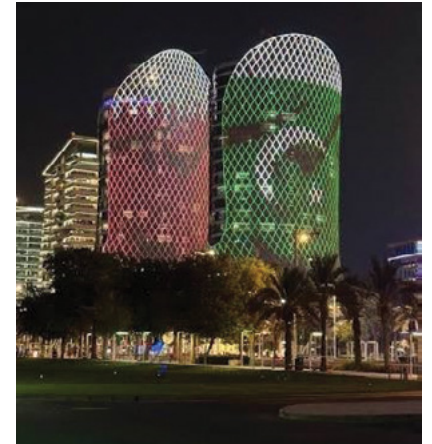

9th International Pakistan Army Team Spirit (PATS) Competition 2026

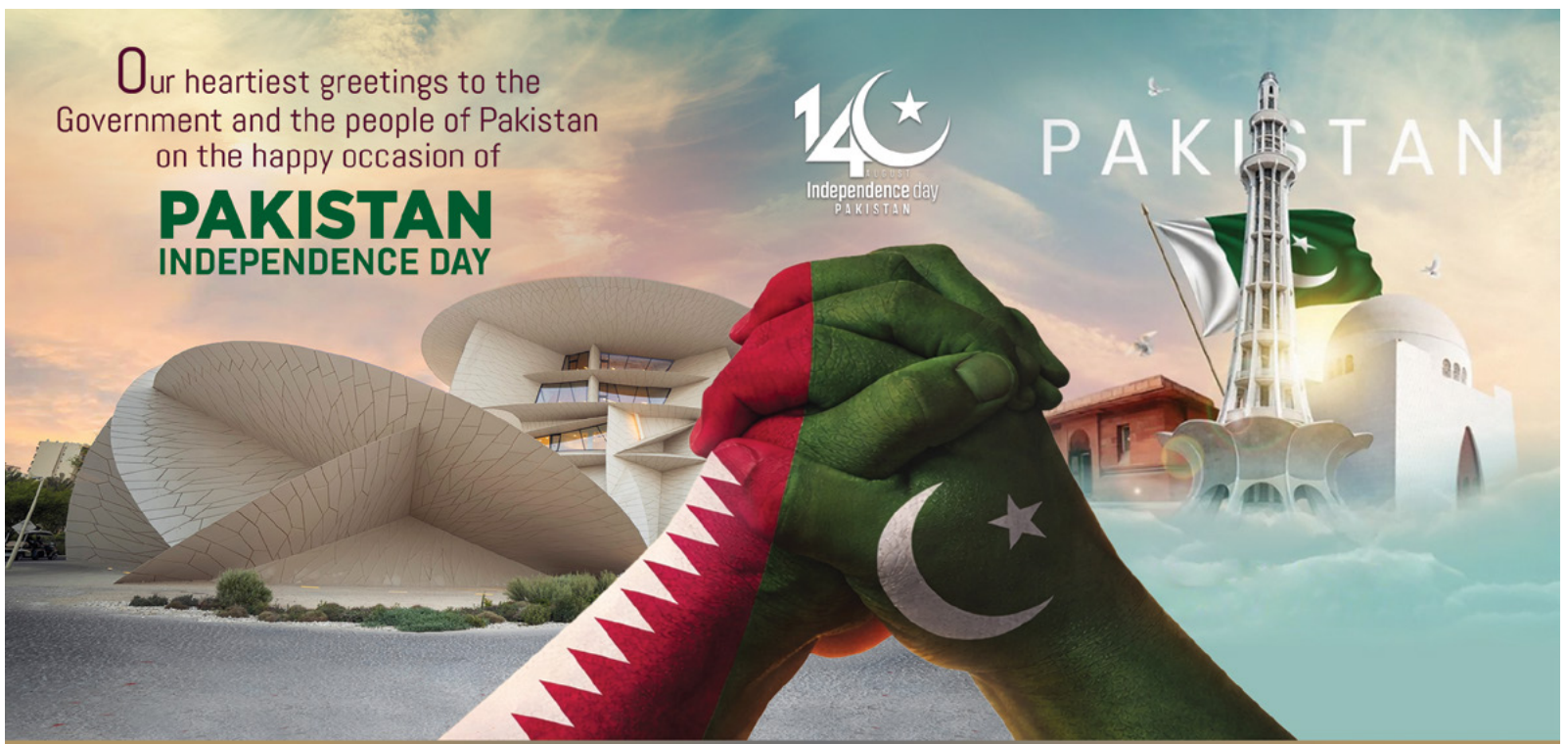
