





PAKISTAN AND QATAR BILATERAL RELATIONS



The brotherly relations between Pakistan and Qatar have flourished over the decades, founded on a profound mutual respect and shared Islamic heritage. These ties have been continuously nurtured through diplomatic engagements, economic cooperation, and cultural exchanges, strengthening the bond between the two nations.

As strategic partners, Pakistan and Qatar have demonstrated a commitment to enhancing their bilateral relationship, leveraging their synergies to promote regional stability and mutual prosperity. This partnership, deeply rooted in Islamic brotherhood and strategic interests, serves as a cornerstone of their foreign relations, paving the way for a future of increased collaboration and shared successes.

Political and Diplomatic Ties

Pakistan and Qatar maintain close high-level contacts, with frequent exchange of visits by heads of state, ministers, and officials. Pakistan has always valued Qatar's role as a key player in the Gulf region and acknowledges its efforts for regional peace and mediation.

Early Ties with Qatar

Since Pakistan's emergence as an independent nation in 1947, it has actively nurtured its historical connections with the Islamic world, including the State of Qatar, which gained its independence in 1971. The establishment of diplomatic relations in 1973 laid a foundation built on mutual respect and Islamic brotherhood, celebrating over fifty two years of diplomatic ties by 2025.

Political Engagements and Diplomatic Exchanges:

The bilateral relationship has been significantly enriched by high-level visits and diplomatic exchanges. Notable visits by Qatar's leadership in 1999, 2015, and 2019, along with reciprocal visits by Pakistan's leadership, have solidified this bond. Successive visits by Prime Minister Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif to Qatar in 2022, 2023 and 2024 opened new opportunities for cooperation, including commitment of substantial investment in Pakistan through Qatar Investment Authority (QIA).

In October 2024, Prime Minister Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif paid a visit to State of Qatar at the invitation of His Highness the Amir Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al-Thani, for inauguration of cultural exhibition Manzar.

Second round of Bilateral Political Consultations (BPC) was held in February 2025. Qatari side was led by Minister of State for Foreign Affairs of the State of Qatar, Sultan bin Saad Al Muraikhi, whereas Pakistani side was led by Foreign Secretary Amna Baloch. The Joint Ministerial Commission (JMC) meeting is expected to be held later this year.

Defense:

Defense relations have been robust, characterized by joint military exercises, personnel training, and strategic military engagements. Pakistan Armed Forces and Qatar Armed Forces enjoy very cordial relations which are based on mutual respect and shared values. It is significant to highlight that Pakistan-Qatar military-military relations are on

continuous rise. In this regard, bilateral visits, training collaboration and joint defense exercises were focused.

During January 2025, Vice Chief of Naval Staff witnessed FTX of the SSG(N)-QNSF bilateral Exercise Muharab Al Bahr held at Qatar. 9th Edition of multinational exercise AMAN-2025 & AMAN Dialogue were held in Pakistan in February 2025. For the first time in history, two Qatari dignitaries — HE Major General Shayeq bin Misfir Al Shahwani Al Hajri, Deputy Chief of Staff, and HE Major General (Sea) Abdullah Ali Al Mazroui, Deputy Commander Qatari Eimir Naval Force — graced the occasion.

The 8th Edition of Pakistan Army Team Spirit (PATS) was held in April 2025. PATS Competition was a rigorous 60-hour-long military patrolling challenge aimed at enhancing multinational military cooperation in a complex global security environment and teams and observers from 20 friendly nations participated in the competition. Qatar Armed Forces team also participated in PATS and demonstrated exceptional skill, physical endurance, mental resilience and professional expertise of troops.

Delegations from National Defence University Islamabad and Pakistan Navy War College visited State of Qatar for Foreign Study Tour.

Economic Ties and Trade Relations

Economically, Qatar is a vital partner in Pakistan's energy sector, with significant trade in LNG since 2015. In addition to cooperation in the LNG sector, the two countries have been exploring investment opportunities in food security, renewable energy, aviation, ports and shipping, media, tourism sectors, as well as IT, minerals and mining, further diversifying their economic interactions

The bilateral total trade volume stood at US \$ 3.613 billion in FY 2024-25, with Pakistan's exports to Qatar amounting to US \$ 113.47 million and imports from Qatar at US \$ 3,500.43 million. The trade balance remains in Qatar's favor, primarily due to Pakistan's import of LNG and petroleum products. Pakistan's exports to Qatar include fruits, vegetables, fresh and frozen fish, bovine and sheep meat, animal feed, bed linen, rice, processed food, and other food items.

Mango Festival

This year, the Embassy of Pakistan, in collaboration with the Celebrations Organizing Committee of the Private Engineering Office (PEO), organized the 2nd Edition of the Al Hamba Festival of Pakistani Mangoes from 10 to 19 July 2025 at the Eastern Square of Souq Waqif, Doha. Building on the success of the inaugural edition held from 27 June to 6 July 2024, the festival formed part of the Embassy's ongoing economic diplomacy initiatives, aimed at promoting Pakistan's premium fresh fruits and related products in the Qatari market. The 2025 edition attracted over 101,200 visitors and achieved record sales of 228,929 kilograms of mangoes and mango-based products, surpassing last year's 224,000 kilograms.

The event featured participation from more than 70 vendors, including seven Pakistani exporters, offering fresh mangoes, innovative mango-based dishes, and a variety of cultural experiences. The festival received extensive coverage in Qatari print and electronic media, further enhancing Pakistan's

image and strengthening bilateral economic and cultural ties.

Pakistan has also been an active participant in Qatar's economic, trade and other events, including Web Summit, Agriteq, Project Qatar, Build Your House, Hospitality Qatar, Cityscape, Falcon and Hunting Exhibitions etc.

Health Sector

Embassy of Pakistan in Qatar, in collaboration with Hamad Medical Corporation's ITQAN Center and Atlantic International Business Network, organized the first-ever Pakistan Healthcare Solutions Conference on June 2, 2025, in Doha to foster bilateral cooperation in the health sector. The event was graced by H.E. Syed Mustafa Kamal, Pakistan's Federal Minister for National Health Services, and Dr. Salih Al Marri, Qatar's Assistant Minister for Health Affairs. The conference featured high-level G2G discussions, targeted B2B meetings between healthcare companies, and panels on R&D collaboration, smart healthcare, and innovation.

An exhibition showcased cutting-edge medical technologies from Pakistan and Qatar, marking a milestone in advancing sustainable health partnerships between the two countries. The Federal Minister also met with his counterpart His Excellency Mansoor bin Ebrahim bin Saad Al Mahmoud, Minister of Public Health.

Diaspora and Human Resource Exchange:

Qatar is home to a significant Pakistani expatriate community of more than 300,000. This substantial diaspora acts as a vital bridge between the two nations, contributing significantly to Qatar's development and serving as a crucial link in bilateral relations. Pakistanis in Qatar play key roles across diverse sectors including construction, health care, transportation, finance, and services, highlighting the deep interpersonal connections that complement formal diplomatic ties. Pakistani migration to Qatar has seen a steady increase over recent years. The sizable Pakistani diaspora in Qatar has made the country an important source of remittances for Pakistan.

Education Cooperation:

Qatar's commitment to development in Pakistan, particularly in education, has been a significant component of bilateral cooperation. Through the Doha-based Education Above All (EAA) foundation and the Qatar Fund for Development (QFFD), Qatar has launched multiple initiatives aimed at improving educational access for out-of-school children in Pakistan. Since 2012, EAA has impacted the lives of approximately 1.33 million out-of-school children. Additionally, EAA's "Educate a Child" program has significantly enhanced educational opportunities for these children.

Cultural Cooperation

The cultural relationship between Pakistan and Qatar has been characterized by vibrant exchanges. Qatar has displayed a strong interest in Pakistani arts, crafts, and culinary traditions, collaborating with Pakistan's Ministry of Culture and local organizations to organize a variety of cultural events that celebrate this shared heritage.




In these engagements, both sides reviewed the existing security cooperation framework, and discussed new areas of collaboration including:



TNG School ranks among the world's top 15% in TIMSS 2023 excellence.

As Qatar continues to position itself as a global hub for education, there are success stories emerging that highlight the country's ability to foster world-class students. One such success story is The Next Generation (TNG) School that has consistently demonstrated excellence in both curricular and extra-curricular activities. The school's outstanding performance in the 2023 Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study (TIMSS) positions it amongst the top 15% of schools worldwide.


Overall Result Comparison - Science



In the 2023 TIMSS Cycle - TNG's third participation - the school achieved remarkable results, with both Year 5 and Year 9 students reaching the 'High International Benchmark' category (scores between 550 - 625). These outstanding scores place TNG students in the top 15% of the participating schools worldwide. Since its first participation in 2015, TNG has shown consistent improvement, with mathematics scores increasing by 18 points at the Year 5 level and 22 points at the Year 9 level. Science scores have similarly improved by 15 points and 19 points respectively, highlighting the school's commitment to continuous educational improvement.

The mathematical skills assessed in TIMSS share crucial overlaps with the IGCSE Enterprise curriculum. In TIMSS, students are

Overall Result Comparison - Math




evaluated on their ability to interpret and draw conclusions from mathematical data - skills that are directly applicable in IGCSE Enterprise. Whether managing a crochet and resin art stall, launching a small business, or selling upcycled crafts, students apply mathematical skills by tracking cash flow, calculating profit and loss, and developing financial plans. These hands-on experiences cultivate entrepreneurial thinking and reinforce the practical relevance of mathematics beyond the classroom.


TNG's exceptional results can be attributed to its rigorous, inquiry-based teaching approach. The school places a strong emphasis on critical thinking, problem-solving, and data interpretation ensuring that students not only memorize formulas but also truly understand underlying mathematical and scientific concepts. Teachers employ modern strategies such as project-based learning and collaborative exercises to cultivate analytical thinking and deepen comprehension. The integration of skills across subjects like Enterprise further strengthens students' abilities, preparing them to excel in international assessments and confidently navigate global challenges.



Pakistan Healthcare Solutions Conference Held in Doha

Fostering Bilateral Collaboration for a Healthier Future

The Embassy of Pakistan in Qatar, in collaboration with Hamad Medical Corporation's (HMC) ITQAN Clinical Simulation and Innovation Center, successfully hosted the Pakistan Healthcare Solutions Conference on June 2, 2025, at the ITQAN Clinical Simulation and Innovation Center in Doha.

The program commenced with inaugural addresses by Javaid I. Sheikh, M.D., M.B.A., Dean of Weill Cornell Medicine-Qatar, and Dr. Abdulla Ahmad Executive Director of the ITQAN Clinical Simulation and Innovation Center. Their remarks underscored the transformative potential of collaborative efforts in

strengthening healthcare systems between Pakistan and Qatar.

Keynote presentations were delivered by Lt. Gen. Arshad Naseem HI (M), Surgeon General of Pakistan, and Prof. Dr. Ambreen Afzal Ehsan, Vice President of the College of Physicians and Surgeons Pakistan. Additional presentations were delivered by Dr. Obaidullah Malik, CEO of the Drug Regulatory Authority of Pakistan (DRAP); Mr. Amr Metwally, Assistant Executive Director at ITQAN; Mr. Ikram UI Haq, President of the Sialkot Chamber of Commerce; Mr. Muhammad Irfan, CEO of Xeven Solutions; and Mr. Tanvir Khan, representing Labware Arabia. These talks showcased innovations in regulatory frameworks, medical technology, and industry partnerships.



An exhibition featured stalls from leading companies such as Allison, Labware, and others, displaying advancements in medical devices, laboratory technologies, and AI-powered solutions. This interactive platform facilitated knowledge exchange and explored potential avenues for future collaboration.

The conference concluded with remarks by Hafiz Muhammad Talha, CEO of AIBN and Managing Director of Metas Qatar, followed by a closing address by HE Muhammad Aamer, Ambassador of Pakistan to Qatar. These victories reflect the rigorous training and enthusiastic participation fostered



by the PE Department, whose dedication to promoting fitness, discipline, and teamwork has been nothing short of inspiring. The Girls Wing also marked a milestone by winning the inter-school badminton tournament, highlighting the inclusive and empowering spirit of sports at PISQ.

Creativity and literary excellence took center stage with the much-awaited Drama Gala 2025, hosted in April. The event brought together all six wings of the school to perform captivating Urdu and English plays, reviving classical literature and showcasing student talent in acting, stage design, and direction. a platform for storytelling and character impersonation. The event strengthened PISQ's reputation as a pioneer in English language and literary events in the region.
