## Pakistani Exports Commodities to Qatar

With efforts of this embassy, bilateral trade has increased as it is worth noting that the export indicators, as reported by the State Bank of Pakistan, showed an increase in the export of fresh, chilled and frozen beef to Qatar, remained USD 24.4 Million in June of FY 2021-22 as compared to USD 18.9 Million FY 2020-21 an increase of 28.9%.

The data also showed that Pakistan's exports of fresh, chilled or frozen sheep or goat meat to Qatar amounted to 6 million dollars in the year 2021, compared to the same period in 2020, exported with a value of 5.8 million dollars, an increase of 3%, and it is expected that exports will increase to Qatar after economic activities returned from their stagnation in the past few years due to the effects of Covid-19.

## **Pakistan Independence Day**

Pakistani meat processing companies, have been awarded contracts worth \$2.2 million for the export of its products to the Middle East, announced in a notice to the Pakistan Stock Exchange (PSX).

This comes after the efforts of the government in Pakistan to develop several fields and industries, including the meat industry and its products of various kinds, where Pakistani meat is distinguished by its high quality and the use of modern technology for years with the development of abbatoirs that meet the requirements of global and international health, which contributed a lot to the development of this field in recent years, which prompted consumers and traders to distinguish Pakistani meat from others in terms of quality and health requirements.

In December 2021, the Ministry of Agriculture of Jordan awarded approval to three slaughterhouses in Pakistan to export meat of bovine animal, sheep, goat and camel meat to Jordan. In September 2021, a Pakistani supplier was awarded a \$1-million contract for the supply of frozen meat to Saudi Arabia. In April 2022, Pakistani meat suppliers were also granted approval by the Chinese customs authorities to export heat-treated beef to China.

Meanwhile, Pakistan exported its "firstever meat consignment to Jordan" in November 2021. At the time, the Ministry of Commerce, Pakistan stated that the promotion and facilitation of nontraditional products to new markets was a result of the Ministry's diversification policy.

Also, Egypt's veterinary quarantine department has approved 10 Pakistani meat processing companies to export Pakistani meat to Egypt.

In relation to Pakistan's trade relations with Qatar, it may be noted that:

 Bilateral relations have been greatly strengthened over the past three years, Pakistan's exports to Qatar



have witnessed growth of 31.19% as shown in theprevious tables, Pakistan's exports to Qatar remained USD 196.601 Million for FY 2021-22, as compared to USD 149.864 Million in FY 2020-21.

 The increase in the export of meat, foodstuffs, vegetables, fresh and frozen fruits, animal feed, in addition increment 3% for FY 2021-22 compared to FY 2020-21.

## Heavy Industries Taxila at a glance

akistan took birth on 14 August 1947 with meagre resources including military and industrial infrastructure, confronting enormous challenges in early years. During 1965 war, Pakistan faced its first arms embargo which propelled our leadership to acquire self-reliance in sustaining its war fighting machines. Consequently, the journey of HIT began on 26th July 1971 with signing of an agreement between Peoples Republic of China and Pakistan for establishment of a heavy rebuild factory at Taxila to rebuild Chinese T-59 Tanks with the help of Ministry of 5th Machine Rebuilding Industry China later to be known as NORINCO Group.

The journey starting from a rebuild and upgrading industrial setup for armoured vehicles is now standing as a flag bearer of quality and innovative solutions for a range of Armoured Fighting Vehicles and related products. As an industrial manufacturer, HIT not only caters for Pakistan Defence Forces, but also other Law Enforcement Agencies. The organization is also endeavoring to become a major exporter of a wide range of world class products to friendly countries. HIT has successfully manufactured around 1800 and carried out rebuild of 5000 AFVs, up till now.

### Tanks - The King of the Battle

The success story began with rebuild of Chinese T-59 Tanks in early 80s and has boastfully reached today at the pinnacle by transforming its capabilities from rebuild to upgradation and new manufacturing of Tanks.

**T85IIAP Tank,** the sentinel of Armoured Corps, has been successfully rebuilt and upgraded with improved engine, enhanced protection and modern control systems of 125mm smooth bore gun.

**T80UD Tank**, the clinched fist of Pakistan Army, was acquired in mid 90s as one of the deadliest,

swiftest and safest machines in the battle field. The Tank, having enhanced protection capabilities with explosive reactive armour and modern fire control systems of fully stabilized 125mm smooth bore main gun, is sustained and being upgraded with superior capabilities.

**Tank Al Zarrar** - an upgradation of T69 Tank - added another feather of success in the glory during late 90s. With most cost effective transformation from humble origin capabilities to improved mobility, protection and fire power of 125mm smooth bore main gun.

The most exquisite of the jewels that HIT adorns today, are the main battle tanks AI Khalid and AI Khalid-1 that forms the backbone of Pakistan Army's Armoured Corps.

During mid-90s, KS&EW started construction of warships. The first naval vessel was a missile craft (PNSSHUJAAT) for Pakistan Navy. Afterwards, Floating dock with self-docking pontoon and lifting capacity of 4000 Tons was also constructed for Pakistan Navy.

KoM has been procured by KS&EW, comprising of several locally developed components. The vessel is equipped with state-of-the-art and indigenously developed weapon systems.

Ship Repair department has a comprehensive setup for repairing, rebuilding and overhauling of naval and commercial vessels with high quality standards. Integrated services are provided through highly qualified workforce. Facilities include dry docks, cranes, quay walls and modern tools to undertake above and underwater repairs. We have already repaired more than 5000 x vessels with 230x foreign flag carriers including China, Turkey, Korea, Singapore, UAE, etc.

In order to enhance ship repair and refurbishment capacity, a state-of-the-art Ship Lift & Transfer System (SLTS) is being installed at KS&EW. Norway. This system is fully operational since Sept 2021 and capable to lift ships upto 7300 tons with is 10 x parking stations for above-water repairs.

General Engineering department is capable to undertake projects of steel/marine structural fabrication (dams/ barrage gates), Cranes and lift equipment (i.e., EOH, luffing and gantry cranes etc.), stadiums flood light towers and wind turbine towers, machining works includes forged steel shafts, sugar rollers and hoisting mechanism from dams/ barrages, rollers for sugar plants and foundry products includes steel billets sugar rollers and alloys casting. The department has recently completed EPC project of

River Sluice Gates Replacement at Sukkur Barrage under the overall project management by World Bank and 2500 Ton marine grade structural fabrication of SLTS platforms, duly certified by Lloyd Register, UK.

Laboratory of KS&EW for material testing was established in 1960, though, initially for rendering assistance to quality control and internal checks on construction projects. Afterward scope of work has been extended to undertake various services including metallurgical analysis, mechanical, physical, chemical, and welding tests required for various external customers. Services range also covers the chemical composition, testing of metals, ferrous and non-ferrous, alloys, refractory, cement etc. The tests are carried out in accordance with BSS/ASTM standards and/or any other classification/standard to comply customer's specific requirement.



Marine Structural Work

The Shipyard Training School (STS) was established in 1957 as an apprentice training school for Marine Engineering. The school has provided prime facilities for technical training of officers, supervisors and workers to enhance their skills in various trades. STS is also contributing to skill development and employment opportunities. Currently, school is undertaking various diplomas, and numerous vocational courses in electrical, mechanical and ship construction technologies etc. STS have so far trained more than 25,000 young entrants in different cadres. It also runs internship programs like Management Trainee Officers (MTOs) and for supervisors training (MTSs). Furthermore, commercial courses are affiliated with STEVTA and technical training in various trades in collaboration and sponsorship by NAVTTC. Furthermore, it is worth mentioned that STS is also certified by TUV Rhineland Centre, Germany for conducting advanced training for metal fabrication and



### **BEAUTIFUL KARAKORAMS**

The Karakorams which means 'black mountains", lying to the north of the western Himalays, stretch for nearly 300 miles from the eastern most part of Afghanistan in a south eastern direction. Having a width of 150 miles, the Karakorams consist of a group of parallel ranges with several spurs. Only the central part is a monolithic rage. Sprawling nearly over 35 and 33 N latitude and lying roughly between 74 and 78 E longitude, the Karakorams are one of the highest mountain systems of 24,000 feet (7320 metres) or above, and four of them are above 26,000 feet (7930 meters). No other mountain system has such a large number of high peaks above 7000 meters. Craggy peaks and steep slopes are characteristic of the range. These mountains also from the boundary between China and the Northern Areas of Gilgit and Baltistan controlled by

### **Broad Peak**

Board peak is the 12th highest mountain in the world at 8,075 meters above sea level. Broad peak is part of the Gasherbrum massif in Baltistan on the border of Pakistan and China. It is located in the Karakoram mountain range about 8 kilometers (5.0 mi) from K2. It has a summit over 1.5 kilometres (0.93 mi) long. The mountain has several summits: Broad Peak (8047 m), Rocky Summit (8028 m), Broad Peak central (8011 m), Broad Peak North (7490 m), and Kharut Kangri (6942 m).

### Gasherbrum-I

Gasherbrum-I is part of the Gasherbrum massif, located in the Karakoram region of the Himalaya. Gasherbrum is often claimed to mean "Shining Wall", presumably a reference to the highly visible face of the neighboring peak Gasherbrum IV; but in fact it comes from "rgasha" (beautiful) + "brum" (mountain) in Balti, hence it actually means "beautiful mountain."



### Nanga Parbat

Nanga Parbat literally, Naked Mountain is the ninth highest mountain in the world at 8,126 meters (26,660 ft) above sea level. It is the western anchor of the Himalays around which the Indus river skirts into the plains of Pakistan. It is located in the Gilgit-Baltistan region of Pakistan and is locally known as 'Deo Mir' 'Deo' meaning 'huge' 'mir' meaning 'mountain'.

### K2

K2, also known as Mount Godwin-Austen or Chhogori



is the second highest mountain in the world, after Mount Everest, at 8,611 metres above sea level. It is located on the China-Pakistan border between Baltistan, in the Gilgit-Baltistan region of northern Pakistan.

Fosco Mariant, the Italian mountaineer, describes k-2 as "the very Patriarch of Mountains, regal, serene, a mountain conceived on a giant scale, given the space and setting that are meet and right for a giant. In the mighty mass of the whole, each single part seems so finely wrought, each one a telling note in a mighty chord, and in the patterning of ridge, colour, rock face and ice fall, thrusting inexorably upwards to the peak, there is the logic of Bach fugue.








## Arshad Nadeem makes nation proud
